## 2007 Chuck Thompson Award

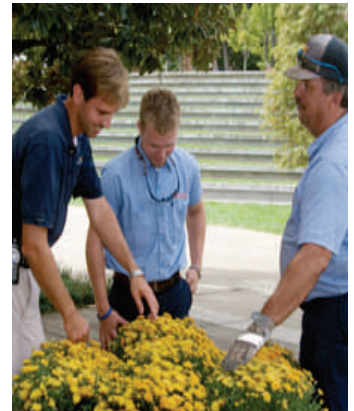
Congratulations to Eursal “Junior” Payne and Kyle Crisp the 2007 Chuck Thompson Award recipients!!

He now oversees the planting of just about every flower, shrub and tree on campus. Jason’s team will plant 10,000 tulip bulbs that will bloom in the spring along with 10,000 pansies to provide color in the winter. This winter Jason & his crew will plant 60 trees around campus to replace those that died and 90 new willow oak trees will be planted down the median of Volunteer Blvd.

Terry received twenty-two nominations from various departments located in Andy Holt Tower.
