The following comments/questions were submitted to the FS comment boxes. Below each comment/question is the response from Interim Associate Vice Chancellor Terry Ledford.

Comment: The new AVC search is particularly concerning. After the candidate visits last year, there has been a deafening silence from Campus Administration, although rumors have run rampant. It is absolutely critical that we establish permanent leadership for Facilities Services. The lack of information and apparent lack of progress cannot be interpreted as anything other than extremely negative. One cannot help but think that this is damaging departmental morale, impeding our ability to retain or recruit quality candidates or perform our critical functions for campus. While Terry has done a great job as an interim, any interim is limited in their ability to do more than just maintain the status quo. We will soon be required to navigate the transition into the new budget model, a radical shift to maintenance and operations funding across UTK. To think that the best path forward through that is interim leadership is dangerously short sighted. It is be bad enough that we are rapidly approaching two years without a permanent leader through a pandemic, but a pandemic in addition to a fundamental shift in funding and oversight paradigms requires a permanent leader with an actual vision of the future

Response: We appreciate your concern. Unfortunately, silence during this part of the process is necessary in order to maintain confidentiality for the candidates. The process is still in motion and will hopefully come to a successful conclusion soon.

As all of you are aware, Mrs. Martha Parker has established the John C. Parker, Sr. Memorial Scholarship Endowment in memory of Mr. Parker. This scholarship endowment will award a scholarship for the 2022-2023 academic year which begins August 2022.
