New Addition to the UT Campus Map

The interactive campus map has an exciting new addition of interior floorplans of three buildings on campus: Student Union, Hodges Library and Haslam Business. Visit maps.utk.edu, and you will see a list of floors on the right side of the map. Scroll up and down through the floors and the map will update to show that floor in all three buildings if it exists (for example, there won't be a floor #5 at the Student Union).

For security purposes, rooms are grouped by department or function when possible to avoid showing details of every single room. For example, suite 282 at the Student Union was grouped as "Visitor Center" instead of showing every single office in that suite. There aren't plans to publish floorplans for other buildings for public viewing due to security concerns.

KUB Home UpLift Program

As winter sets in, we want to make sure our team is aware of KUB's Home Uplift program that provides eligible customers with free home energy improvements aimed at saving you hundreds of dollars on utility bills while increasing efficiency and comfort in your home. These upgrades may include a new or repaired HVAC unit, insulation, appliances, and more.

If you are a current KUB customer who owns or rents a single-family home with a total household income of \$55,000 or less for a family of four and willing to participate in a home energy evaluation, you'll likely qualify. 
